Narrative Lectionary 2020-2021

Readings for Year 3 (Luke)

The **preaching texts** are always listed first. Old Testament texts are the primary vehicle for proclaiming the biblical story until the Fourth Sunday of Advent, when the gospel readings become primary texts. An optional accompanying reading (selected from the gospels before Christmas and after Easter; from Psalms Christmas through Easter) is noted in parentheses.

September	13	NL301: Creation and Fall Fifteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Genesis 2:4b-7, 15-17; 3:1-8 (Luke 11:4) Creation, Garden of Eden, fall into sin.
September	20	NL302: God's Promise to Abraham Sixteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Genesis 15:1-6 (Luke 3:8) God promises Abraham descendants as numerous as the stars. Abraham believes.
September	27	NL303: God Works through Joseph Seventeenth Sunday after Pentecost	Genesis 37:3-8, 17b-22, 26-34; 50:15-21 (Luke 6:35) Joseph's dreams lead to family conflict and he is sold into slavery. In the end Joseph forgives. God works for good.
October	4	NL304: The Promise of Passover Eighteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Exodus 12:1-13; 13:1-8 (Luke 22:14-20) Passover: the blood of the lamb and unleavened bread signify God's sacrifice of the lamb God's deliverance.
October	11	NL305: Golden Calf Nineteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Exodus 32:1-14 (Luke 23:34) Golden calf shows unfaithfulness at Mt. Sinai. Moses intercedes, God forgives.
October	18	NL306: God Answers Hannah Twentieth Sunday after Pentecost	1 Samuel 1:9-11, 19-20; 2:1-10 (Luke 1:46-55) Samuel is God's answer to Hannah, who sings of God's care for the needy.

October	25	NL307: God's Promise to David Twenty-first Sunday after Pentecost (or Reformation)	2 Samuel 7:1-17 (Luke 1:30-33) God's promise to David concerning his heir, who will be God's Son and whose kingdom will endure forever.
November	1	NL309: God's Care for the Widow Twenty-second Sunday after Pentecost (or All Saints)	1 Kings 17:1-16 [17-24] (Luke 4:24-26) Elijah and the widow; God's care for those on the margin.
November	8	NL310: Jonah and God's Mercy Twenty-third Sunday after Pentecost	Jonah 1:1-17; 3:1-10 [4:1-11] (Luke 18:13) Jonah's attempted escape from God, God's mercy on the people of Nineveh.
November	15	NL311: God Calls Isaiah Twenty-fourth Sunday after Pentecost	Isaiah 6:1-8 (Luke 5:8-10) Call of Isaiah: Holy, holy, holy is God; the prophet's sin, cleansing, and sending.
November	22	NL312: God Promises a New Covenant Christ the King / Reign of Christ Sunday	Jeremiah 36:1-8, 21-23, 27-28; then 31:31-34 (Luke 22:19-20) Jeremiah's scroll calls for repentance, but the king burns it. The prophet promises a new covenant, written on the heart.
November	29	NL313: Daniel's Hope in God First Sunday of Advent	Daniel 6:6-27 (Luke 23:1-5) Daniel in the lions' den; deliverance; God's kingdom shall never be destroyed.
December	6	NL314: Joel: God's Promised Spirit Second Sunday of Advent	Joel 2:12-13, 28-29 (Luke 11:13) Turn to a merciful God, promise of the Spirit.

December	13	NL315: Spirit of the Lord upon Me Third Sunday of Advent	Isaiah 61:1-11 (Luke 4:16-21) The Spirit of the Lord is upon me to bring good news, liberty, and to make an everlasting covenant.
December	20	NL316: Jesus' Birth Announced Fourth Sunday of Advent	Luke 1:26-45 [46-56] (Psalm 113) Announcement of Jesus' birth to Mary; he will receive the throne of David.
December	24	NL317: Birth of Jesus Christmas Eve	Luke 2:1-14 [15-20] (<i>Psalm 96</i>) Birth of Jesus.
December	25	NL318: Shepherds Visit Christmas Day	Luke 2:8-20 (Psalm 123:1-2) Shepherds visit the infant Jesus.
December	27	NL319: Simeon and Anna First Sunday of Christmas	Luke 2:21-38 (Psalm 131) Simeon and Anna, Lord now you let your servant depart in peace.
January	3	NL320: Boy in the Temple Second Sunday of Christmas	Luke 2:41-52 (Psalm 2:7-8) Jesus in the temple at age twelve. He is in "his Father's house."
January	10	NL321: Jesus' Baptism Baptism of Our Lord	Luke 3:1-22 (Psalm 51:6-17) John baptizes, bear fruit worthy of repentance, share what you have.
January	17	NL322: Sermon at Nazareth Second Sunday after Epiphany	Luke 4:14-30 (Psalm 146) Sermon at Nazareth (Isaiah fulfilled, Elijah and widow, Elisha and Naaman).
January	24	NL323: Fish for People Third Sunday after Epiphany	Luke 5:1-11 (Psalm 90:14-17) Great catch of fish, Peter will fish for people.

January February	7	NL324: Healing on the Sabbath Fourth Sunday after Epiphany NL325: Raising the	Luke 6:1-16 (Psalm 92) Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath (plucking grain, healing a man) and call of disciples. Luke 7:1-17 (Psalm 119:105-107)

February	17	NL330: Jesus Turns to Jerusalem Ash Wednesday	Luke 9:51-62 (Psalm 5:7-8) Jesus starts for Jerusalem, rejected in Samaria, Don't put your hand to the plow and turn back.
February	21	NL331: Good Samaritan First Sunday in Lent	Luke 10:25-42 (Psalm 15) Parable of the Good Samaritan
February	28	NL332: Lament over Jerusalem Second Sunday in Lent	Luke 13:1-9, 31-35 (Psalm 122) The tower in Siloam and need for repentance, parable of fig tree that bore no fruit, lament over Jerusalem.
March	7	NL333: Lost Sheep, Coin, Son Third Sunday in Lent	Luke 15:1-32 (Psalm 119:167-176) Parables of lost sheep, coin, prodigal son.
March	14	NL334: Rich Man and Lazarus Fourth Sunday in Lent	Luke 16:19-31 (Psalm 41:1-3) Parable of the rich man and Lazarus.

March	21	NL335: Zacchaeus Fifth Sunday in Lent	Luke 18:31—19:10 (Psalm 84:1-4, 10-12) Healing a blind man, meeting Zacchaeus. Jesus came to seek and save the lost.
March	28	NL336: Triumphal Entry Palm/Passion Sunday	Luke 19:29-44 (<i>Psalm 118:19-23</i>) Triumphal entry; Jesus weeps over the city that does not know peace.
April	1	NL337: Last Supper Maundy Thursday	Luke 22:1-27 (Psalm 34:8-10) Preparation for the Last Supper, Words of Institution, Jesus is one who serves.
April	2	NL338: Crucifixion Good Friday	Luke 23:32-47 (Psalm 31:5-13) Crucifixion, Father forgive them; today in Paradise; into your hands I commend my Spirit.
April	4	NL339: Resurrection Resurrection of Our Lord	Luke 24:1-12 (Psalm 118:17, 21-24) Empty tomb, women perplexed, bring the message.
April	11	NL340: Emmaus Road Second Sunday of Easter	Luke 24:13-35 (Psalm 30) "Our hearts burned along the road, as he opened to us the Scriptures."
April	18	NL341: Stephen's Witness Third Sunday of Easter	Acts 6:1—7:2a, 44-60 (Luke 23:33-34a, 46) Controversy in the early church; some set aside for service. Stephen forgives and is martyred.
April	25	NL342: Ethiopian Eunuch Baptized Fourth Sunday of Easter	Acts 8:26-39 (Luke 24:44-47) Ethiopian reads the Scriptures, comes to believe and be baptized by Philip.
