Narrative Lectionary 2022-23

Readings for Year 1 (Matthew)

The **preaching texts** are always listed first. During the fall, Old Testament texts are the primary vehicle for proclaiming the biblical story. The gospel readings become primary texts on the Fourth Sunday of Advent. A brief accompanying reading (selected from one of the gospels before Christmas and after Easter; selected from Psalms from Christmas through Easter) is noted in parentheses. *These accompanying readings are optional*.

September	18	NL102 Call of Abraham Fifteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Genesis 12:1-9 Call of Abraham, promise of land, descendants, blessing to the nations (Matt 28:19-20, Go therefore and make disciples of all nations)
September	25	NL103 Joseph in Prison Sixteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Genesis 39:1-23 Joseph is unjustly put in prison; yet God is present with him there (Matt 5:11-12, Blessed are you when people revile you)
October	2	NL104 Rescue at the Sea Seventeenth Sunday after Pentecost	Exodus 14:5-7, 10-14, 21-29 The sea parts at the exodus; God's deliverance (Matt 2:13-15, Mary, Joseph, and Jesus in Egypt, out of Egypt have I called my son)
October	9	NL105 Covenant and Commandments Eighteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Exodus 19:3-7; 20:1-17 God brings Israel as on eagle's wings; Decalogue (Matt 5:17, Jesus came not to abolish the law and prophets but to fulfill them)
October	16	NL106 Joshua Renews the Covenant Nineteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Joshua 24:1-15 [16-26] Story of God's deliverance. Joshua says, "As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord" (Matt 4:8-10, Satan offers Jesus all kingdoms, but Jesus says "Worship God and serve only him")

October	23	NL107 David and Bathsheba Twentieth Sunday after Pentecost	2 Samuel 11:1-5, 26-27; 12:1-9; Psalm 51:1-9 Nathan's parable indicts David after his sin with Bathsheba. David is moved to repent. (Matt 21:33-41, Parable about the wicked tenants)
October	30	NL108 Solomon's Wisdom Twenty-first Sunday after Pentecost	1 Kings 3:4-9, (10-15), 16-28 Solomon prays for wisdom; two women and a child (Matt 6:9-10, Pray in this way, "Our Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come")
November	6	NL109 Elisha Heals Naaman Twenty-second Sunday after Pentecost	2 Kings 5:1-15a Elisha heals Naaman, a foreigner and leper (Matt 8:2-3, Jesus heals a leper, "I will, be clean")
November	13	NL110 Micah Twenty-third Sunday after Pentecost	Micah [1:3-5]; 5:2-5a; 6:6-8 God promises a ruler from Bethlehem; desires justice, kindness, walking humbly with God (Matt 9:13, God wants mercy, not sacrifice)
November	20	NL111 Swords into Plowshares Christ the King / Reign of Christ Sunday	Isaiah 36:1-3, 13-20; 37:1-7; then 2:1-4 Assyria threatens Jerusalem and King Hezekiah despairs. Isaiah says the city will be saved and nations will beat swords into plowshares. (Matt 5:14, light of the world, city on a hill)
November	27	NL113 Faith as a Way of Life First Sunday of Advent	Habakkuk 1:1-7; 2:1-4; 3:[3b-6], 17-19 The prophet, grieved by injustice/suffering, watches for God's reply. Faith is a way of life, not an answer. (Matt 26:36-38; In Gethsemane Jesus is grieved and asks disciples to watch with him)
