Narrative Lectionary 2025-26

Readings for Year 4 (John)

The **preaching texts** are always listed first. During the fall, Old Testament texts are the primary vehicle for proclaiming the biblical story. The gospel readings become primary texts on the Fourth Sunday of Advent. A brief accompanying reading (selected from one of the gospels before Christmas and after Easter; selected from Psalms from Christmas through Easter) is noted in parentheses. *These accompanying readings are optional*.

September	7	NL401 Creation by the Word Thirteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Genesis 1:1—2:4a Creation by word; light, life; it was good. (<i>John 1:1-5</i>)
September	14	NL402 Binding of Isaac Fourteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Genesis 21:1-3; 22:1-14 God gives Abraham and Sarah a son in their old age. Abraham is told to sacrifice his son, but God provides the ram. (John 1:29)
September	21	NL403 Jacob's Dream Fifteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Genesis 27:1-4, 15-23; 28:10-17 Jacob gets a blessing by trickery, flees, dreams of a ladder with angels ascending and descending. Receives God's promise. (John 1:50-51)
September	28	NL404 God's Name Is Revealed Sixteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Exodus 2:23-25; 3:1-15; 4:10-17 God's name is revealed: "I Am." Moses is a reluctant messenger, but God uses him to deliver Israel. (<i>John</i> 8:58)

October	5	NL405 God Provides Manna Seventeenth Sunday after Pentecost	Exodus 16:1-18 People complain, God provides manna. Manna requires faith in what God gives. (<i>John 6:51</i>)
October	12	NL406 God Calls Samuel Eighteenth Sunday after Pentecost	1 Samuel 3:1-21 God calls Samuel in the night. He says, Speak Lord for your servant is listening. Told to warn others of sin in Israel. (<i>John 20:21-23</i>)
October	19	NL407 God Calls David Nineteenth Sunday after Pentecost	 1 Samuel 16:1-13; Psalm 51:10-14 God does not look on outward appearance but on the heart; create in me a clean heart. (John 7:24)
October	26	NL408 Solomon's Temple Twentieth Sunday after Pentecost (or Reformation Sunday)	 1 Kings 5:1-5; 8:1-13 Solomon's temple – a place of sacrifice and divine presence. (John 2:19-21)
November	2	NL409 God Speaks to Elijah Twenty-first Sunday after Pentecost (or All Saints Sunday)	 1 Kings 19:1-18 Elijah at Horeb; The prophet in despair, God speaks in the silence. (John 12:27-28)
